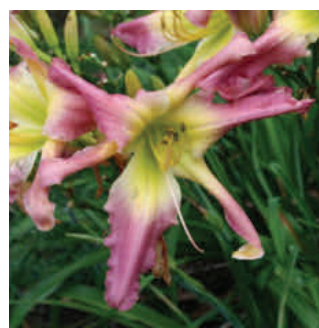
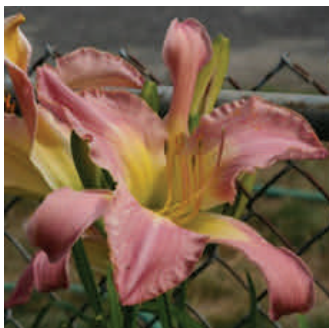
Thanks to everyone who contributed their time and efforts to a successful Exhibition.
